Re: S. Fulton Authority Project Update

<u>Water Withdrawal Application/Process:</u> By email dated May 14, 2018, EPD requested revisions to the water withdrawal application and supplemental documentation. The requested revisions were made and the complete water withdrawal application was resubmitted to EPD on May 15, 2018. By letter dated June 7, 2018, EPD requested additional revisions as well as documentation that has previously been provided. A response is being prepared and anticipated to be submitted in the upcoming week.

<u>Treatability Analysis</u>: Water quality testing which included multiple monthly samples from the Chattahoochee River began on January 22, 2018 and will be complete on June 11, 2018 as contemplated in the EPD-approved water quality testing scope. The associated treatability analysis will be completed on June 12th. So far, all samples are within the range appropriate for water supply and can be treated in accordance with accepted traditional protocols. The treatability report will be prepared by Krebs Engineering and provided to the Authority for its consideration for submission to EPD at the July Authority meeting.

<u>SWAP</u>: ARC received authorization and funding for completion of the required SWAPs for the metro-Atlanta area. ARC is initiating work on the SWAP on June 19, 2018 and will be complete with all participating water providers by the 2020 deadline.

GEFA Loan Update: The GEFA loan documents were approved and submitted to GEFA following the February 13, 2018 Authority meeting. By letter dated February 16, 2018, GEFA provided the 10 forms for draws to be submitted for payment under the loan. GEFA further provided that a billing statement will be provided, and the 1% origination fee was withdrawal from the Authority's account in April. Under the terms of the loan, the Authority is obligated to draw on the funds within six months from the date of loan execution (February 19, 2018) or pay a monthly continuation fee of \$3,000.

Please note that the Authority is still required to "expend unobligated funds, those other than obligated funds which are calculated as a good-faith estimate of debt service (principal and interest) based upon increasing annual payments for the 2014 refunding bonds prior to drawing upon the GEFA loan funding" as specified in the modification memorandum.

<u>Mitigation Contract</u>: The Mitigation Management is currently moving through the regulatory process to permit the mitigation site as an approved mitigation bank. We will provide updates to the Authority as they become available, however the outside closing date under the approved terms is June 30, 2020.

ACF Water Control Manual: The lawsuits discussed in the previous update are still pending. No injunction has been issued that would prohibit EPD or the USACE to stop issuing permits. We have spoken to USACE Office of Counsel and are awaiting formal written confirmation of the USACE official position that the direct withdrawal is deemed as a practical alternative and not deemed speculative in the absence of an injunction during the course of litigation. Delays in obtaining this statement have been cited by the USACE due to coordination of USACE districts and pending litigation considerations.

<u>Supreme Court Update</u>: The ruling on the January 8, 2018 oral arguments before the Supreme Court are expected before June 30, 2018.

<u>Timeline:</u> An updated timeline of the activities over the past year is attached for your review.
